Ski Program Details

- \$95 per person for a Friday night pass (good any Friday Song is open, anytime of day)
- 6 weeks of lessons beginning on January 11th (time will be announced)
- Discounted rentals
 - Must purchase 6-punch card at signups \$66/ski and \$105/snowboard
 - Additional rentals will be issued at the same nightly price break but you **must** present your expired card to get the discounted price
- Bus transportation to Song is available for \$5/person for the season. (purchased separately)
- Wendy Moltion is the main advisor, plus at least 1 per 10 participants will be present.
- Advisors keep a table in the lodge for skiers to report to and advisors ski in shifts.
- Skiers will be issued a picture badge and must have it on at all times at the mountain.

Song Mountain Terms and Conditions

- The operation of Song Mountain is at the sole discretion of management and may be dictated by weather, snow conditions, safety concerns and many other uncontrollable variables.
- Lost or stolen passes should be reported immediately. \$50 replacement fee on lost/stolen passes.
- No refunds will be allowed after December 24th 2007.
- Song Mtn. has the right under Article 18 of the NYS Obligations Law to, without refund, remove from the ski area, deny skiing privileges and/or arrest anyone whose conduct, excesses or attitudes, as determined by management or Ski Patrol, create a hazard or nuisance for anyone.

Responsibility Code

- Always stay in control and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
- People ahead of you have the right of way.
- Do not stop where you obstruct a trail, or are not visible from above.
- Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others as needed.
- Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
- Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails/areas.
- Prior to using any lifts, you must have the knowledge/ability to load, ride and unload safely.
