

FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the boundaries of the proposed Fire Protection District are the same as co-terminus with the boundary lines of the Township of LaFayette; and no petition having been filed, but this Town Board, acting upon its own motion and without petition, having designated June 18, 1945, at eight o'clock P.M. at the Grange Hall in the said Town of LaFayette, New York as the time and place for a public hearing; and

WHEREAS a notice in due form, containing a description of the proposed Fire Protection District and specifying the time when and the place where the Town Board would meet to consider the proposition for the establishment of such a Fire Protection District and to hear all persons interested in the subject concerning the same, was duly published and posted as required by law and

WHEREAS, pursuant a public hearing was duly held by the Town Board of the Town of LaFayette on 18th day of June 1945, commencing at eight o'clock P.M. at the Grange Hall in the Town of LaFayette, Onondaga County, New York, being within the limits of the proposed Fire Protection District; and

WHEREAS all persons interested who desired to be heard were duly heard, and due deliberation having been had, now upon the evidence given at such public hearing and on motion of Mr. Monte Coye, seconded by Mr. Frank Parks.

RESOLVED, pursuant to Article II of the Town Law, State of New York, that it is hereby determined that it is in the public interest to establish a Fire Protection District in the Town of LaFayette; and that it is in such interest that there be an (upon the granting of permission therefore by the State Comptroller) there hereby is established a Fire Protection District within the Town of LaFayette, Onondaga County New York, to be known as the LaFayette Fire Protection District and to be contained in and embraced in the following boundaries; that the boundaries of said Fire Protection District shall be the same boundaries as the Township of LaFayette and the boundaries of said Fire Protection District shall be co-terminus with the boundaries of the Township of LaFayette and it is further

RESOLVED that this Town Board does hereby find and determine that all the property, property owners and interested persons within the proposed Fire Protection District are benefited thereby and that all property or property owners benefited are included therein.

FURTHER RESOLVED that John M. Crowe, as Supervisor of the Town of LaFayette, is hereby authorized and directed to execute a petition to the comptroller of the State of New York for the approval of the establishment of such Fire Protection District in said Township; and the Town Clerk of said town is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution in the Office of the County Clerk of the County of Onondaga and also to file a certified copy of said resolution in duplicate in the Office of the State Department of Audit and Control at Albany New York with an application in duplicate for permission to create such District.
