

**TOWN OF LAFAYETTE  
LOCAL LAW NO. 4 OF THE YEAR 1985**

**A LOCAL LAW PROHIBITING PARKING  
ON DODGE ROAD AND ONATIVIA ROAD**

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of LaFayette as follows:

**SECTION 1.** No motor vehicle or other vehicle of any kind shall be allowed or permitted to park in the highway right-of-way on either side of the entire length of Dodge Road in the Town of LaFayette, Onondaga County, New York.

**SECTION 2.** No motor vehicle or other vehicle of any kind shall be allowed or permitted to park in the highway right-of-way on either side of the entire length of Onativia Road in the Town of LaFayette, Onondaga County, New York.

**SECTION 3.** Erection of Signs

"No Parking" signs shall be erected by the Town Superintendent of Highways on the highways referred to above.

**SECTION 4.** Ordinance to be Obeyed.

Any person operating a motor or other vehicle of any kind on the highways referred to above shall obey this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** Penalties for Offenses.

Any person violating this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punishable by a fine of \$10.00 for the first offense and by a fine of \$25.00 for each offense thereafter.

**SECTION 6.** This Ordinance shall take effect 10 days after publication according to law"
