

## **PARKING ORDINANCE**

The Town Board of the Town of LaFayette, New York, does ordain and enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** No motor vehicle or other vehicle of any kind shall be allowed or permitted to park in the highway right-of-way on both sides of Apulia Road from its intersection with the centerline of Dodge Road to a point 2000' to the north in the Town of LaFayette, Onondaga County, New York.

**SECTION 2.** Noting in Section 1 of this Ordinance shall prohibit the residents of the above described "No Parking" existing structures for personal or farm use.

**SECTION 3.** Erection of Signs.

"No Parking" signs shall be erected by the Town Superintendent of Highway on the portions of Apulia Road where parking is prohibited.

**SECTION 4.** The Ordinance to be Obeyed.

Any person operating a motor vehicle or vehicle of any kind on the highways referred to above shall obey this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** Penalties for Offenses.

Any person violating this Ordinance shall upon conviction be punishable by a fine of \$10.00 for the first offense and by a fine of \$25.00 for each offense thereafter.

**SECTION 6.** This Ordinance is enacted to amend a prior Ordinance adopted by the Town Board on July 14, 1980 in connection with parking on Apulia Road.

**SECTION 7.** This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after publication according to law.
