SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT

Between

NYSDOT and Town of LaFayette

THIS AGREEMENT, dated January 9, 2024, is between the People of the State of New York, hereinafter referred to as "State" or "NYSDOT" and the Town of LaFayette, hereinafter referred to as "Municipality." Pursuant to Section 99-r of the General Municipal Law, the State and the Municipality wish to share services, exchange or lend materials or equipment which shall promote and assist the maintenance of State and Municipal roads and highways and provide a cost savings by maximizing the effective utilization of both parties' resources. Shared Services shall mean any service provided by one party (Provider) to another party (Recipient). The State and the Municipality agree to share services as follows:

1. Description and Cost of Services, Materials or Equipment to be shared: Provide details of the services, materials or equipment to be shared in the attached standard Schedule A. The total amount of the agreement shall not exceed twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00). If applicable, indicate that the return exchange will be determined at a later date.
2. The Provider's employees shall remain under full supervision and control of the Provider. The parties shall remain fully responsible for their own employees for all matters, including but not limited to, salary, insurance, benefits and Workers Compensation.
3. If the borrowed machinery or equipment is damaged or otherwise needs repair arising out of or in connection with the Recipient's use, the Recipient shall be responsible for such repairs.
4. The Municipality agrees to defend and indemnify the State for any and all claims arising out of the Municipality's acts or omissions under this Agreement.
5. The term of this Agreement shall be for one (1) year from Jan 1, 2024 to Dec 31, 2024. The parties will endeavor to provide no less than thirty (30) days' notice of its intent to extend the Agreement. Either party may revoke this Agreement by providing sixty (60) days written notice of such revocation. Upon revocation, any outstanding obligations of the parties must be satisfied within thirty (30) days of the date of such revocation.

Highway Superintendent Report - January 2024

Roads: Miscellaneous and general maintenance to our roads, shoulders, ditches and culverts will continue through the winter as weather permits. All snow removal equipment is ready. Snow and ice ops – 11 times for snow and no ice.

Highway Business: I would like to ask the Town Board for a resolution to authorize the Supervisor to sign the 2024 Shared Service Agreement with NYSDOT.

I would like to ask the Town Board for a resolution to surplus miscellaneous parts and equipment (see attached photos). All equipment that will be auctioned is no longer on inventory due to age or was donated to the highway dept. The parts and filters go to equipment that the town no longer owns. I would like to posted on Auctions International in the next month or so with no reserve and the revenue to be placed into the Equipment Reserve to reduce future bond costs.

E-mail from Mark Burger OCSWCD: In 2015 the Onondaga County SWCD started to recognize municipal partners for the excellent conservation work that they do in their community.

In 2023, The Town of LaFayette Highway Department competed against other municipalities for the award.

The SWCD District Board of Directors chose, by ballot vote, the Town of LaFayette for their cutting-edge research and demonstration project using live edge snow plow blades which help to reduce salt and sand applications, while maintaining a safe riding surface for their community members.

This project demonstrated that not only did the Town reduce salt and sand usage, they also reduced the number of passes through the town, which in turn reduced the amount of fuel consumed. This reduced the highway department's carbon footprint.

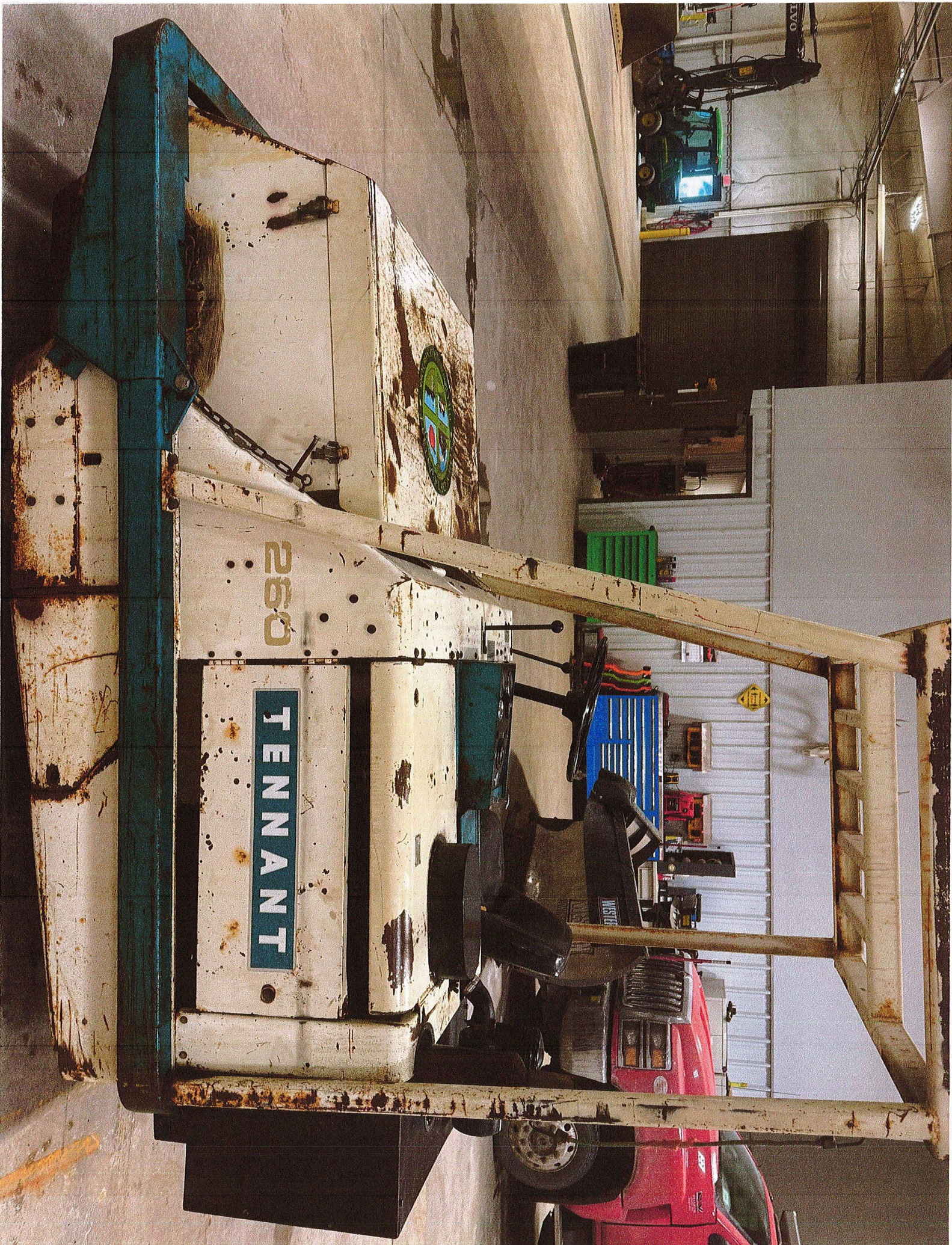
Water quality and aquatic habitat were also benefactors through reduced salt and sand usage and carbon emission reductions.

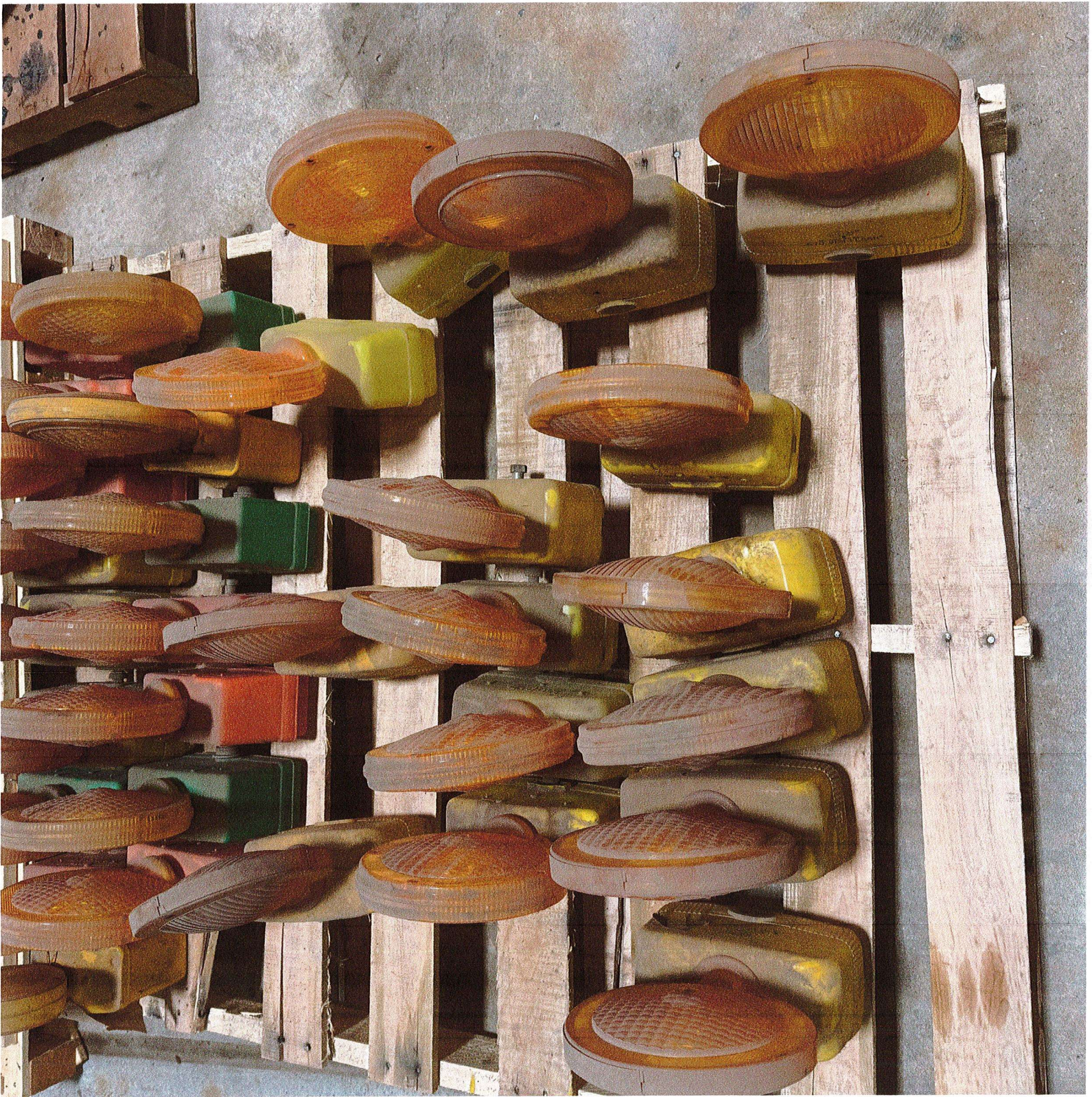

The department also sends a representative to the southern section meeting and county chiefs meeting once a month and they average about 3 hours each.

Here is the Annual report for the Town LaFayette Board.

In 2023, we had one of our best years to date, hired great additional staff, fully staffed the ambulance over 70% of the week on average, and also assisted in neighborhoods all over the county, as required.

We had a Total of 461 runs.

- 126 ALS Transports
- 11 BLS Transports
- 118 Cancellations, en-route.
- 59 Patient refusals
- 81 Mutual aid assisted calls.
- 66 calls to assist other areas.

For 2023 we had an average response time of 3.09 Minutes, with an average arrival time of 7.35 minutes.

We staffed a total of 11,116 part-time hours, which is an average of 213 hours staffed per week. That was made up of a medic only sometimes, and a fully staffed team, the rest of the time.

In 2014, we are looking forward on reporting on our new Full-time program, as well as other changes.

These are the LACC activities between December 6, 2023 to January 4, 2024:

1. **Membership** – No membership changes during this period.
2. **Meetings** – No meeting was held during this time period.
3. **Projects & Programs** - See attached status summary of projects requested by the Town Supervisor and programs selected to build a community conservation culture. Of note:
 - a. **Memorial Tree & Bench Program:** The memorial tree and bench program at Stafford Park has been expanded to include Bailey Park, as you approved in November. The program's webpage was updated and the expansion was announced on social media and in the January newsletter.
 - b. **LED Conversion:** The Town received a \$8.9k check from National Grid as its incentive rebate to the Town for conversion of its streetlights to LED. Earlier this year, the Town received a \$5k check from a NYSERDA grant that covered the balance of the LED conversion cost. The LACC will be comparing streetlight electric bills for this winter to those of last winter.
