

NO-PARKING ORDINANCE FOR COUNTY GARAGE ROAD

The Town Board of the Town of LaFayette, New York enacts the following ordinance as follows:

SECTION 1.

Parking Prohibited on County Garage Road. No motor vehicle or other vehicle of any kind shall be allowed or permitted to park in the highway right-of-way on both sides of County Garage Road (also known as County Route 267) in the Town of LaFayette, Onondaga County, New York.

SECTION 2.

Erection of Signs. "No Parking" signs shall be erected by the Town Superintendent of Highways along the entire length of County Garage Road in the Town of LaFayette.

SECTION 3.

The Ordinance to be Obeyed. Any person operating a motor vehicle or vehicle of any kind on county Garage Road in the Town of LaFayette shall obey this Ordinance.

SECTION 4.

Penalties for Offenses. Any person violating this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of \$10.00 for the first offense and a fine of \$25.00 for each offense thereafter.

SECTION 5.

This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after publication according to law.
