LOCAL LAW NO. 3-2012**

**A Local Law Amending Local Law 3-2009 relating
to an Exemption from Real Property Taxes for Cold War
Veterans as Authorized by Section 458-b of the New York State
Real Property Tax Law, to Provide a New Definition for Cold War Veteran**

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of LaFayette that Local Law 3-2009 is hereby amended to change the definition of "Cold War Veteran", so that it shall read in full as follows:

“Cold War Veteran. A person, male or female, who served on active duty in the United States Armed Forces during the time period from September 2, 1945 to December 26, 1991, was discharged or released therefrom under honorable conditions.”

Effective Date.

This Local Law shall take effect upon its filing with the New York Secretary of State.




