Be it enacted by t	he Town Boa	of the

**Section 1.** The title of Chapter 137 of the Code of the Town of LaFayette is hereby amended to read "Dog and Cat Control."

**Section 2.** Chapter 137, section 137-1 of the Code of the Town of LaFayette (Purpose and findings) is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

The purpose of this chapter is to protect the health, safety and well-being of persons and property within the Town of LaFayette through the licensing and identification of dogs, and by imposing restrictions and regulations upon the keeping of dogs and cats. The Town of LaFayette, New York finds that the uncontrolled behavior of dogs and cats has caused physical harm to persons, damaged property, and created nuisances within the Town.

**Section 3.** Chapter 137, section 137-3 of the Code of the Town of LaFayette (Title) is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

The title of this chapter shall be "Dog and Cat Control."

**Section 4.** Chapter 137, section 137-4 of the Code of the Town of LaFayette (Definitions) is hereby amended to add/modify the following definitions:

CAT – Any member of the species Felis catus.

HARBOR – To provide food, water, or shelter to any dog or cat.

**Section 5.** Chapter 137, section 137-9 of the Code of the Town of LaFayette (Restrictions) is hereby amended to add the following provisions:

## § 137-9 **Restrictions.**

- D. Conditions for keeping dogs and cats. All premises occupied or used by dogs and cats shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition. Failure to provide adequate food, water, or space shall subject a dog or cat to seizure and confinement. "Adequate" shall mean sufficient for age, size, and number of dogs and cats on the premises. Upon conviction of the owner or harborer, the dog or cat becomes the property of the Town of LaFayette, to be released to an authorized humane society, veterinarian, or kennel for adoption or euthanasia.
- E. Dog and cat sanitation. All accumulations of dog and cat feces, excrement, droppings, manure, dung, or solid waste matter shall be stored in such places and be removed with such frequency as determined by the New York State Health Department, Onondaga County Health Department, and/or Town Dog Control Officer in such manner as to prevent offensive or noxious conditions/odors.

**Section 6.** Chapter 137, section 137-11 of the Code of the Town of LaFayette (Complaints) is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

Any person who observes a dog or cat in violation of this chapter may file a complaint under oath with the Dog Control Officer specifying the nature of the violation, the date thereof, a description of the dog and the name and residence, if known, of the owner/harborer of the dog or cat. Such complaint may serve as the basis for enforcing the provisions of this chapter.

**Section 7.** Chapter 137, section 137-13 of the Code of the Town of LaFayette (Violations; penalties for offenses) is hereby amended to add the following provisions:

§ 137-13

- A. (6) Any owner or harborer of cats or dogs to fail to maintain their premises in a clean and sanitary condition.
  - (7) Any owner or harborer of cats or dogs to fail to prevent offensive or noxious conditions/odors.

**Section 8.** This Local Law is effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.
