**Accept SOTS trash rates for 2007.**

Councilman Knapp said they had an informational meeting a couple of weeks ago for the 4 towns. There were a couple of residents present. They answered several questions. They did some market research in the area and as of 1/1/07, the rates for comparable services for the southern end of the county are right in the neighborhood of \$400/year plus tax so he still think we are well below what the market rate is. There is no

1-bag service out there from a private hauler. There are senior citizen rates but nothing for the rest of the folks. It's a jump from last year but it looks like most of them are jumping. This is due to the fuel costs as well as the labor issue. We are hoping the labor issue can be resolved and maybe we can get something back on the contract. There is a fuel provision in the contract too. He thinks it's a pretty good agreement. After this year, the future years have no major increases. He thinks we will be O.K. He thinks most people realized what the going rate was from other private entities. They found this wasn't a big deal. He would encourage everyone to accept the rates.

Supervisor Scammell asked for any questions or comments. There were none.

**Councilman Knapp moved and Councilman Bailey seconded the motion to accept the 2007 SOTS rates as follows:**
